## Loop 1 | Easy - Strum Open Chords with Simple Rhythm

E. Guitar

Chord diagrams and strumming patterns for G, D, Em, and C. The strumming pattern is ddu udu, with a 1 2 + (3) + 4 + rhythm. The fretboard diagrams show the strumming direction for each chord.

## Loop 2 | Another Way to Play Chords | Strum Close to Bridge
